

DCVLGA AUTUMN FOURSOMES AND KILLARD LEAVY

When played: September

Eligibility

Membership: Open to all DCVLGA members who have paid their annual subscription at least one month prior to the competition.

Max Hcp Index: 40.4 at date of entry.

Autumn Foursomes: Players must submit an entry form and pay the competition entry fee prior to the closing date. The entry fee will be published on the competition poster which, together with the entry form and the closing date, can be found on the DCVLGA website.

Killard Leavy Entry: The first round to be played as a Foursomes in each Club, then each Club nominates the winning pair as their entry into the Killard Leavy at the Autumn Foursomes. The club runners-up should be nominated as reserves and can be used individually or as a pair as necessary.

Killard Leavy entries are automatically entered for the Autumn Foursomes if they are not the Killard Leavy winners or runners up. Entries for the Killard Leavy should be made by the Club Representative.

Handicap: Half combined handicaps using full course handicap allowance.

Format: Foursomes Stableford.

Qualifier: No, though the rules will be applied as if it were a qualifier. Therefore Rule 18 of the R&A/USGA Rules of Golf will apply in respect of Stroke and Distance Relief; Ball Lost or Out of Bounds; Provisional Ball. No alternative local rule is permitted.

Number of Holes: 18, off red tees. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the competition will be deemed to have been completed provided the course has remained open to allow no less than 9 holes to have been completed by all entrants.

In the event of a tie: Countback shall be applied to the last 9/6/3/1 holes. If a tie still arises the last 6 holes of the first 9 holes (or 3 or 1) will be used.

Prizes:

- Killard Leavy Cup** – presented to the overall winner of those nominated by their club as representatives in the competition.
- Killard Leavy Runners Up Trophy** – presented to the Killard Leavy runners up.
- Autumn Foursomes** – prizes will be given, the number dependent upon the number of entries.

Prizes will be in the form of Gift Vouchers.
Each player may only win one prize.

2's Competition

Payment for a 2's competition will be collected on the day. If no 2's are scored, a draw will take place and balls will go to players still in the clubhouse.

Presentation:

Immediately following the conclusion of the competition, unless Covid restrictions prevent this.
