

DCVLGA COMBINED MIXED FLITCH VASE AND MIXED GREENSOMES

When played: July

Eligibility

Membership: Open to all DCVLGA members who have paid their annual subscription at least one month prior to the competition. The Flitch is for mixed married couples and the Mixed Greensomes for pairs where the male is aged 60 or over.

Max Hcp Index: Ladies 40.4, Men 28.4, at date of entry.

Entry: Players must submit an entry form and pay the competition entry fee prior to the closing date. The entry fee will be published on the competition poster which, together with the entry form and the closing date, can be found on the DCVLGA website.

Handicap: The handicap for each pair will be calculated as per the CONGU Greensomes chart using the players' course handicaps.

Format: Mixed Greensomes Stableford, played off the Ladies' card.

Qualifier: No, though the rules will be applied as if it were a qualifier. Therefore Rule 18 of the R&A/USGA Rules of Golf will apply in respect of Stroke and Distance Relief; Ball Lost or Out of Bounds; Provisional Ball. No alternative local rule is permitted.

Number of Holes: 18. Ladies off red tees, men off yellow tees. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the competition will be deemed to have been completed provided the course has remained open to allow no less than 9 holes to have been completed by all entrants.

In the event of a tie: Countback shall be applied to the last 9/6/3/1 holes. If a tie still arises the last 6 holes of the first 9 holes (or 3 or 1) will be used.

Prizes: **Flitch Vase and a gammon joint** – presented to the overall winner of the Mixed Flitch competition.
Bookends – Presented to the winning pair of the Mixed Greensomes.
Additional prizes – the number of additional prizes will depend upon the number of entries, will include a visitors prize if numbers permit, and will be in the form of **Gift Vouchers**.
Each pair may only win one prize.

2's Competition Payment for a 2's competition will be collected on the day. If no 2's are scored, a draw will take place and balls will go to players still in the clubhouse.
